# Prelude

## Welcome

**Gathering Prayer:** *Visio Divina, "Sacred Prayer." In visio divina, we prayerfully invite God to speak to our hearts as we look at an image. You can follow these steps if you find them helpful.* 

**Center.** As you gaze at the image, notice your breath and your body.

**Meditate.** Consider the whole image. Notice the shapes, the colors, the lighting, the mood. Notice what's in the foreground and background. How do you feel looking at the image? If you were in the image, where would you be? Now consider what about the image most draws your

attention and let your eyes focus there for a while. Why do you think this particular part strikes you? Do you sense an invitation? What is God saying to you?

**Pray.** What is your response or prayer? Articulate to yourself any words that arise.

**Rest.** Thanking God for what God has revealed, rest in communion with God.
